

EAST SIDE ALANO CLUB OF MADISON, INC. HOUSE RULES

The East Side Alano Club of Madison, Inc. (*hereinafter*, ESAC) is a non-profit corporation dedicated to providing aid and assistance to persons recovering from substance abuse by furnishing and maintaining physical facilities for educational, recreational and social activities supplemental to Alcoholics Anonymous (A.A.) and other 12 step programs.

Non-members are welcome in the clubhouse one-half hour before and one-half hour after scheduled meetings and may attend as many meetings as they wish.

Non-members may be in the Clubhouse as guests of members, if they are discussing AA, Al-Anon or other 12 Step programs, if they are meeting with a sponsor, or if they are attending a club event.

Participation in ESAC's activities is subject to adhering to ESAC's guidelines for appropriate conduct. The following activities are **prohibited** for the welfare of our members and guests.

1. Possession or use of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs on ESAC property.
2. Abusive language or bullying toward a member, volunteer or visitor.
3. Illegal gambling in any form.
4. Failure to follow ESAC's bylaws or policies.
5. Violation of Federal, state or city laws and ordinances.
6. Parking in fire lane.
7. Smoking or "vaping" within the building.
8. Explosives, firearms, knives and other dangerous or illegal material on ESAC property.
9. Overnight parking on the property without permission from the president or vice-president of the Board of Directors.
10. Pets in the building except sanctioned service animals. Unleashed pets on the grounds.
11. Solicitation of money, sexual favors or living quarters.
12. Sale of unapproved items within the clubhouse.
13. Unsupervised children.
14. Inappropriate clothing or bare feet.
