



**Acceptable Use Policy**  
**East Side Alano Club of Madison**

The East Side Alano Club (ESAC) offers free wireless internet (WiFi) access to members using their laptop computers or other mobile devices.

The following conditions must be accepted before users may access the Internet:

1. Members must be current in their payment of dues.
2. By choosing to use this free wireless service you agree to abide by the Acceptable Use Policy that prohibits abusive or illegal activity while using the Club's wireless Internet service.
3. It is the responsibility of the user to understand the policies and his/her obligation to refrain from viewing inappropriate websites, spamming or any illegal activities.
4. Printing is not available over the Wi-Fi network.
5. Wireless users should not transmit credit card information, passwords or any other sensitive personal information over the Club's wireless network as the Club's wireless network is not secure. Anti-virus and security protection are the responsibility of the user.
6. Use of the wireless network is at your own risk and the East Side Alano Club is not responsible for any loss of data or for theft or damage to personal equipment or software.
7. Caretakers provide the password for the WiFi network once a member has signed an agreement to abide by the Acceptable Use Policy. Caretakers cannot provide technical assistance to members using the Club's wireless network. Caretakers cannot configure your laptop or mobile device. The WiFi network is intended for members with prior knowledge and some experience using the Internet.
8. There is no guarantee that a wireless connection can be made or maintained. This service is not to be used as a permanent connection. The connection shall not be used for commercial purposes.
9. The Club reserves the right to terminate a wireless Internet session at any time.

**Acceptable Use Policy (AUP)**

- The East Side Alano Club (ESAC) does not censor or endorse viewpoints found within information accessed through the Internet.
- Children under the age of 16 must have parental permission, in writing, to use the Internet.
- ESAC assumes no responsibility of the parent or guardian to determine what is appropriate.
- A filter has been installed on this network. This gives ESAC the flexibility to select acceptable internet content. A filtering device does not replace a parents/guardians' responsibility to supervise what is appropriate content for minors to access over the internet. A filter is not always effective in blocking access to materials in violation of the Club's Internet policy.
- Information on the internet changes constantly and internet users must be aware that not all of the information found on the internet is current, accurate, or comprehensive.
- ESAC is not responsible for any illegal activity or commercial activity conducted while using the internet or e-mail. Illegal acts involving ESAC's internet connection are subject to prosecution by local, state, or federal authorities.
- In order not to intrude on other members' enjoyment of ESAC, internet users agree to refrain from displaying text or graphics that could be considered offensive to others.
- ESAC reserves the right to decline providing WiFi services if the content is determined to be obscene, indecent, vulgar, hateful, malicious, racist, defamatory, fraudulent, libelous, treasonous, excessively violent or promoting the use of violence or otherwise harmful to others.
- ESAC is not responsible for any loss of data, damage, or liability that may occur from use of the Internet network.
- Any violation of internet rules will result in suspension of WiFi use. The first violation will result in suspension of use for one month. The second violation will result in suspension for one year. Reinstatement is not automatic. The East Side Alano Club Board of Directors must be petitioned for reinstatement of WiFi privileges after a one-year suspension.
