

Hello All,

We are getting by thanks to all who are keeping their membership up to date, attending meetings, or donating in any way (financially or in person by attending meetings). Our net revenue is \$1,455.80 which seems like a good amount. Except it includes a \$800 donation from the family of Betty Pomeranke who was in both programs and died a while ago. The family wanted to donate an object so the board decided to use the money for two new meeting signs, one for upstairs and one for downstairs. They will be installed soon and will be very easy to read and maintain.

So far, \$250 has been received for Hickory Hall air conditioning. This is reflected in the profit and loss report. Meeting donations are up \$326 from September and \$390 from January. Mortgage interest is down from \$513 in January to \$395 in October.

I am working on getting our mortgage refinanced to a lower rate which would help a lot financially.
