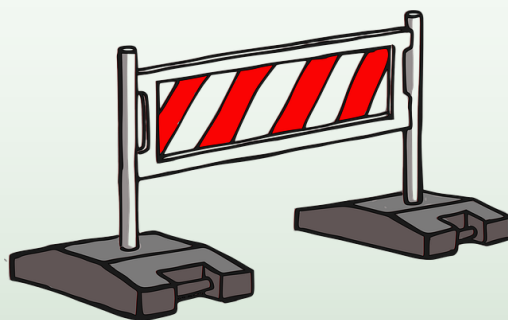

We are showing our support for those in recovery by shining purple lights in September for National Recovery Month. This is a program sponsored by “Purple Lights for Recovery”. Represented here by “Safe Community of Madison and Dane County. Representatives from this organization gave a presentation at our August Board of Directors meeting. The presentation included discussion of NARCAN overdose kits as well as information about September Recovery Month.
