We had some big expenditures in February. With the exception of utilities, these expenses do not include our regular expenses.


1. \$1,431 for Building Maintenance which includes \$673 for plumbing, sewer maintenance and fire and safety testing.
2. \$758 for snow plowing thru February 19. As of this writing date we are in the midst of another big snow storm.
3. Insurance \$3,427 for the year
4. \$1,238 for Utilities
