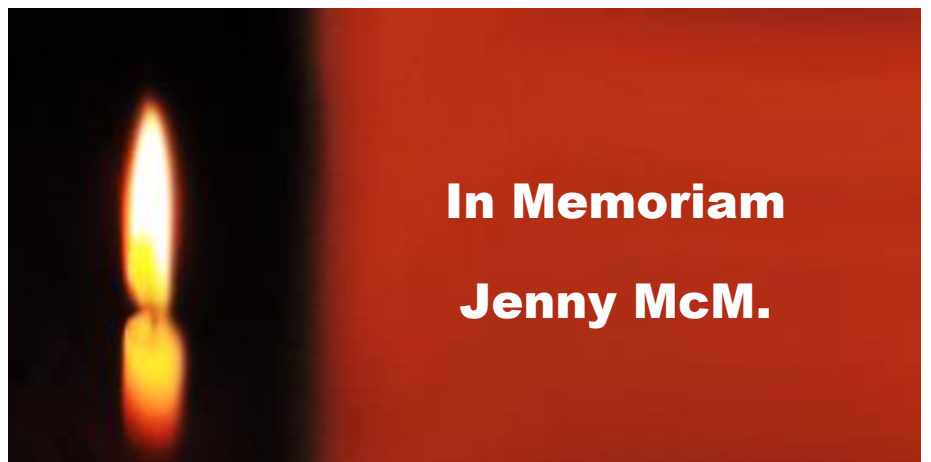


To all members that attended the Annual Membership Meeting. The 2024 Budget for the ESAC was approved unanimously!
