PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING CLUBHOUSE RULE CHANGES:

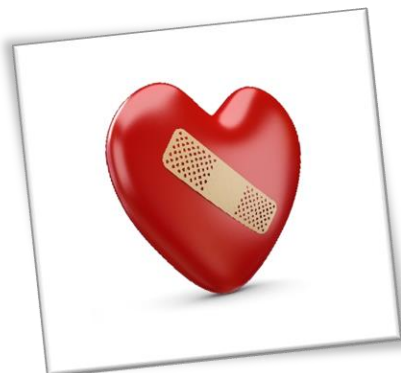
No-Smoking Policy:

- The No-Smoking Policy included in the House Rules has been expanded to **prohibit smoking within 25 feet of any building entrance or open window.**
- This updated policy is posted on the ESAC Bulletin Boards.
- The ESAC Board made this decision to make sure we can provide a smoke-free environment for meetings and events, and in response to complaints about smoke coming in from the back door and affecting inside meeting space.

Game Playing:

- The Pool and Ping-Pong Policy has been updated to include Card Playing and to clarify that any game playing is only allowed when the Clubhouse is open and a Caretaker is on-site, and that game playing must cease before any scheduled meeting or event.
- This updated policy is posted on the ESAC Bulletin Boards.
